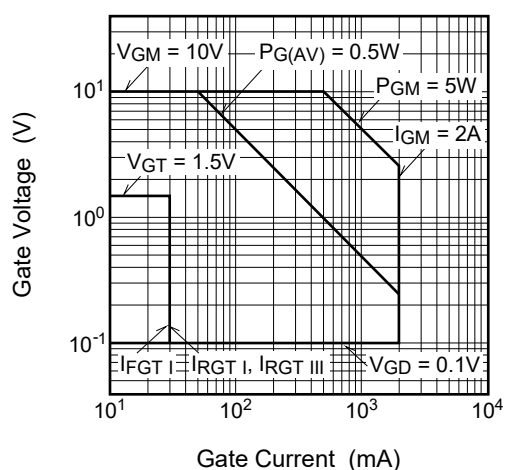
Maximum On-State Characteristics



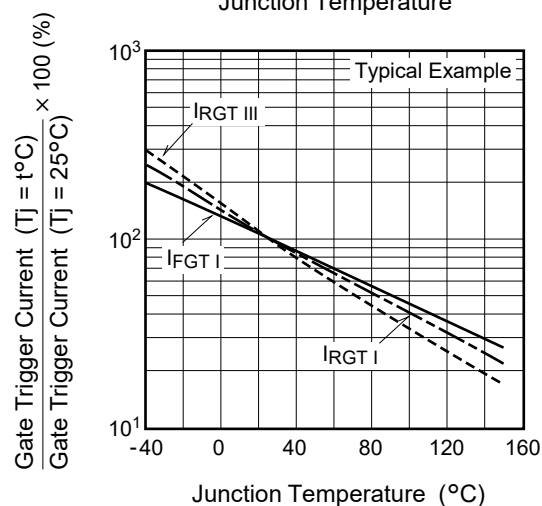
Rated Surge On-State Current



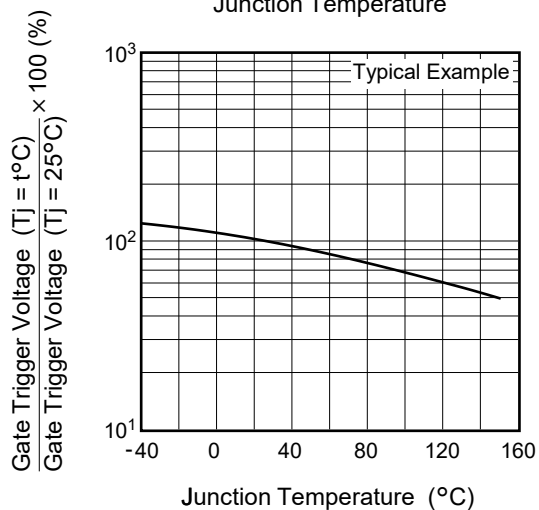
Gate Characteristics (I, II and III)



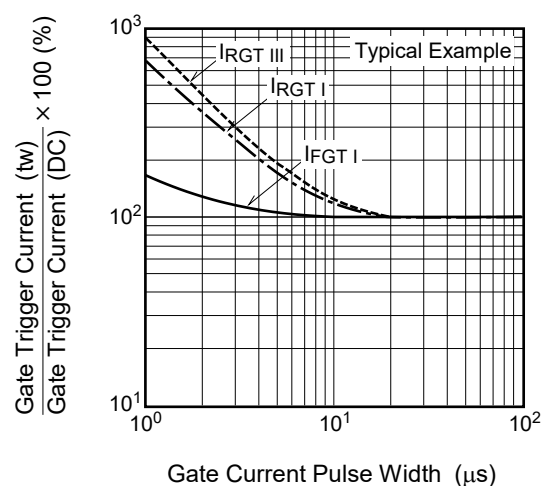
Gate Trigger Current vs. Junction Temperature

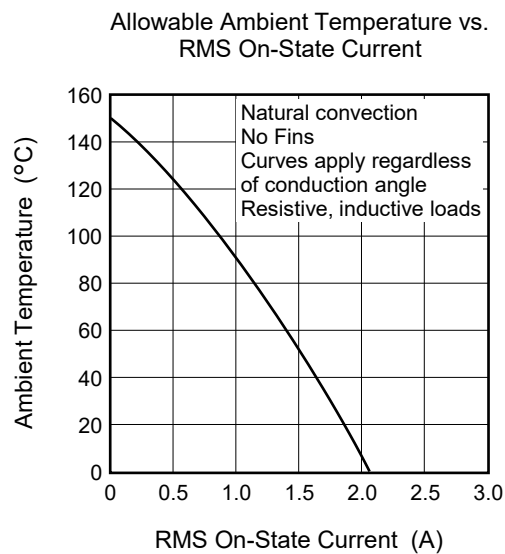
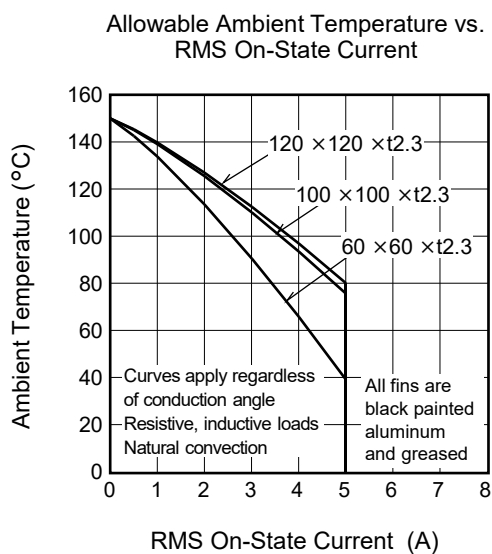
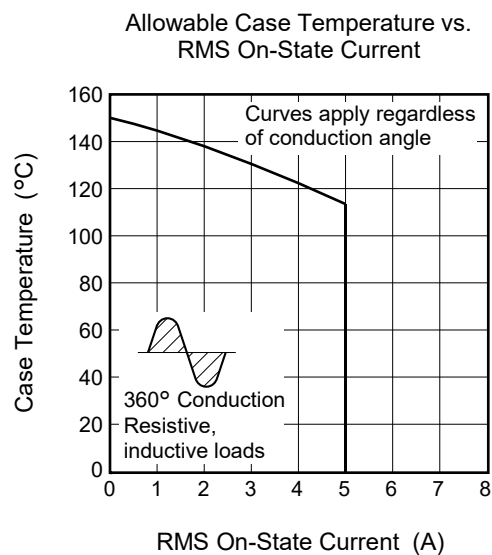
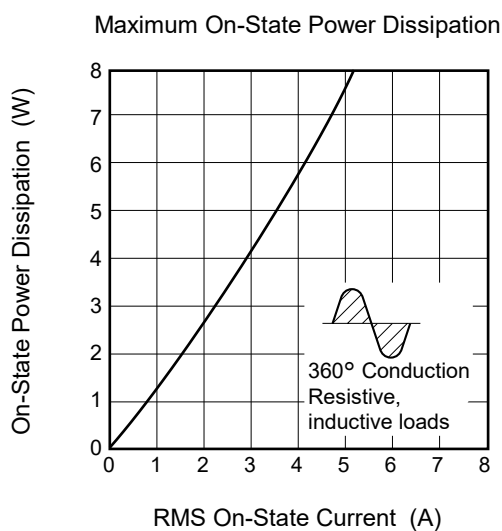
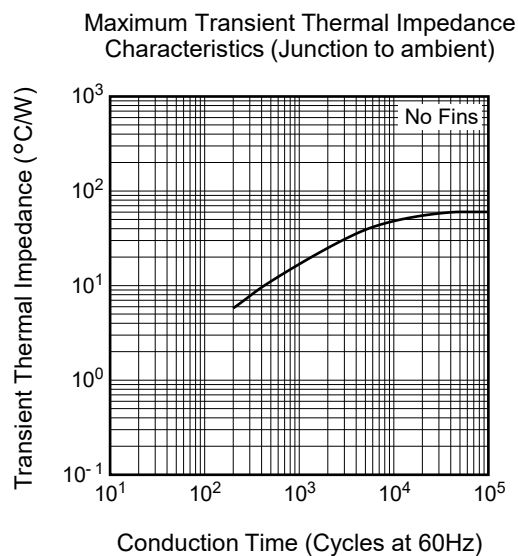
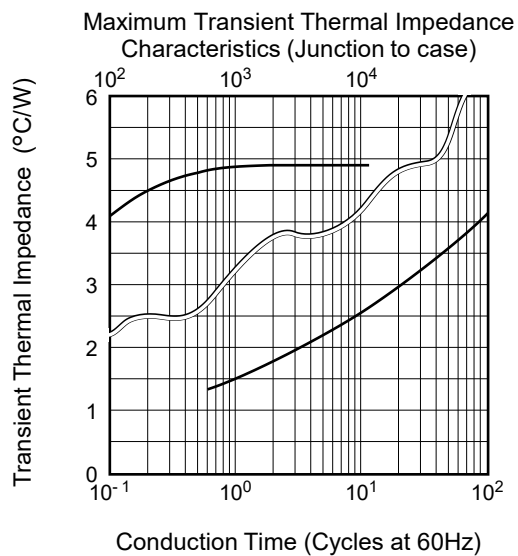


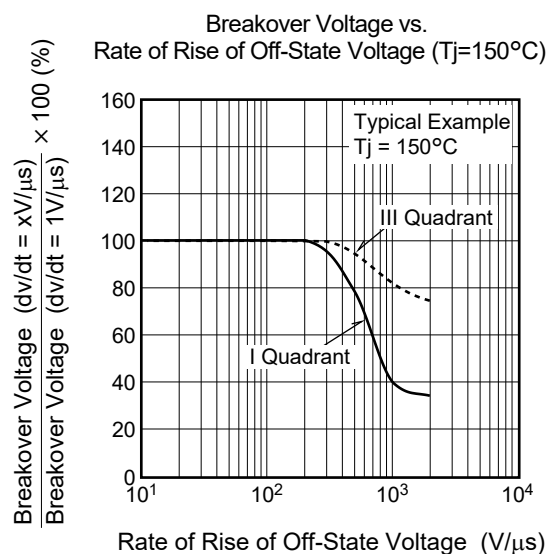
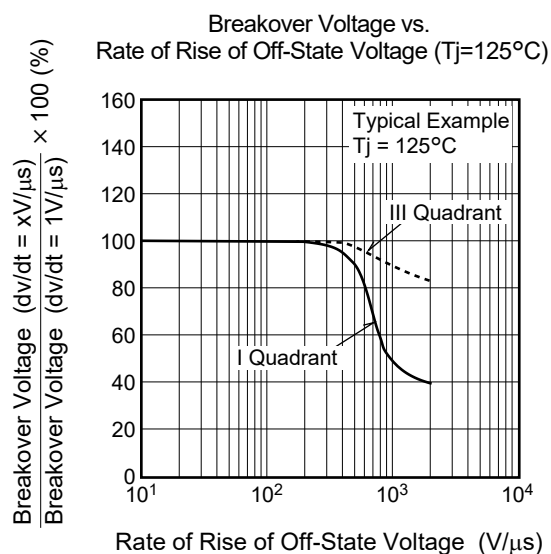
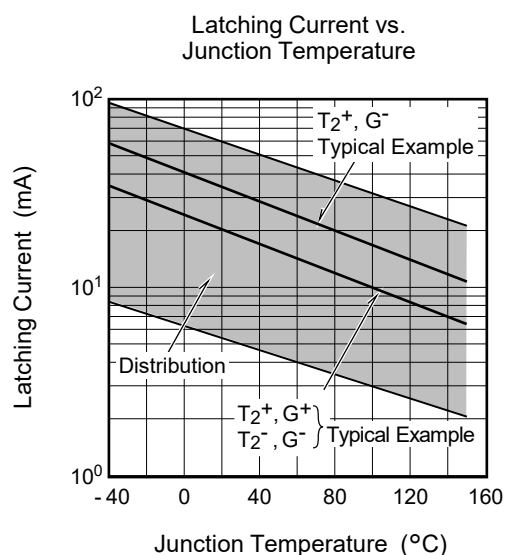
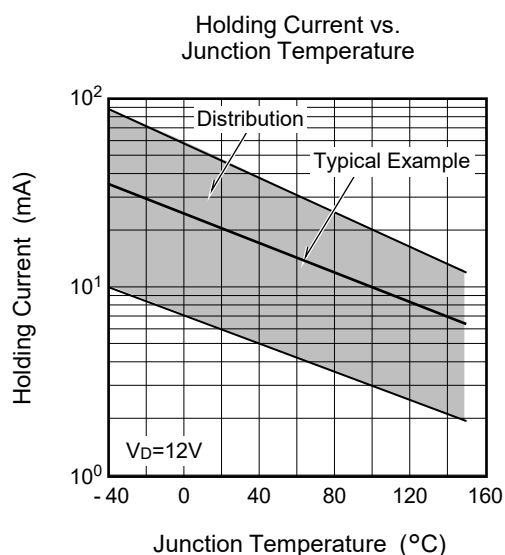
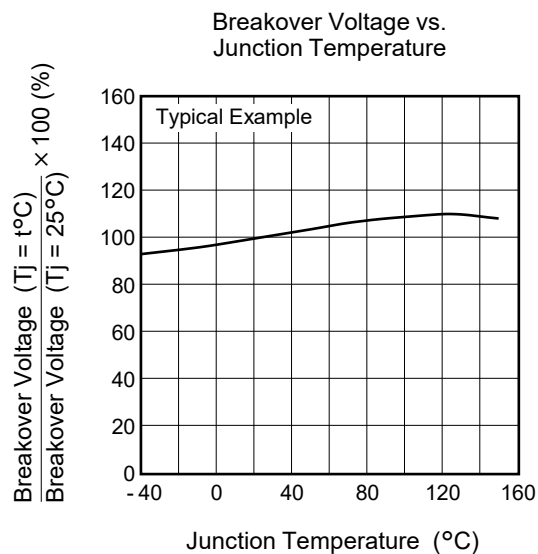
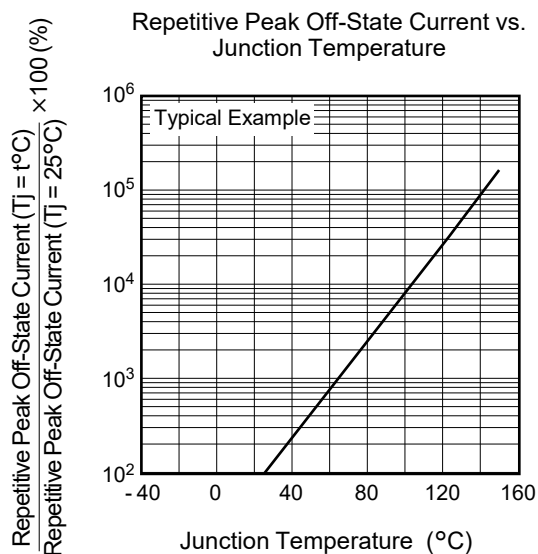
Gate Trigger Voltage vs. Junction Temperature

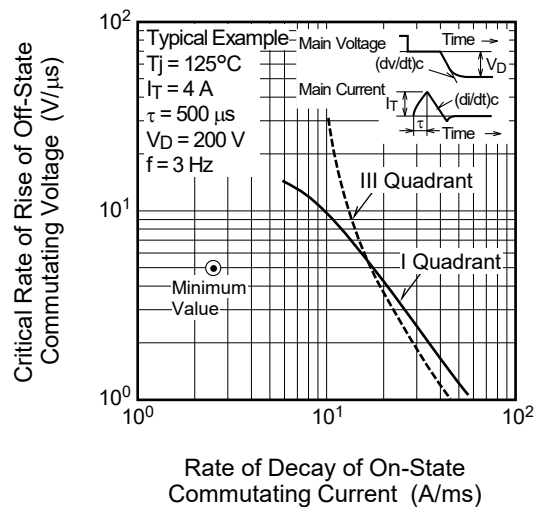
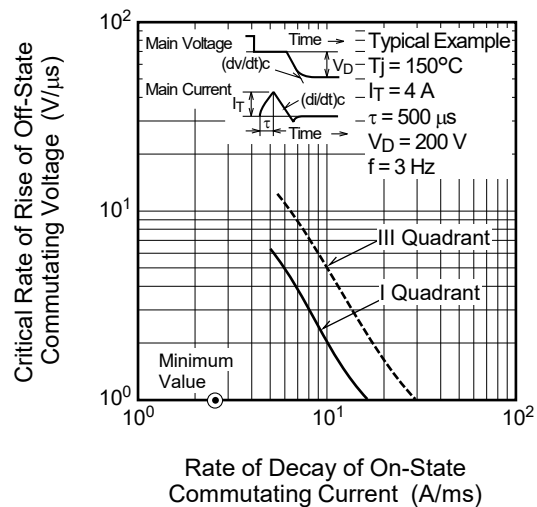


Gate Trigger Current vs. Gate Current Pulse Width

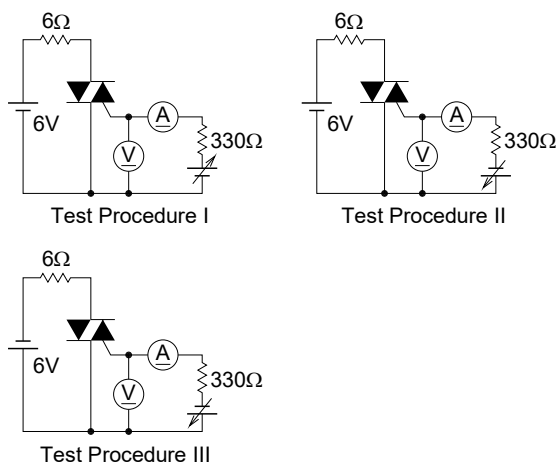




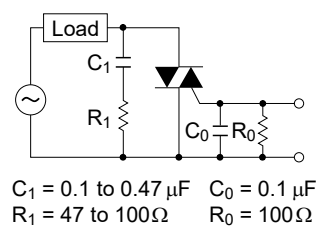


Commutation Characteristics ($T_J=125^\circ\text{C}$)Commutation Characteristics ($T_J=150^\circ\text{C}$)

Recommended peripheral components for Triac

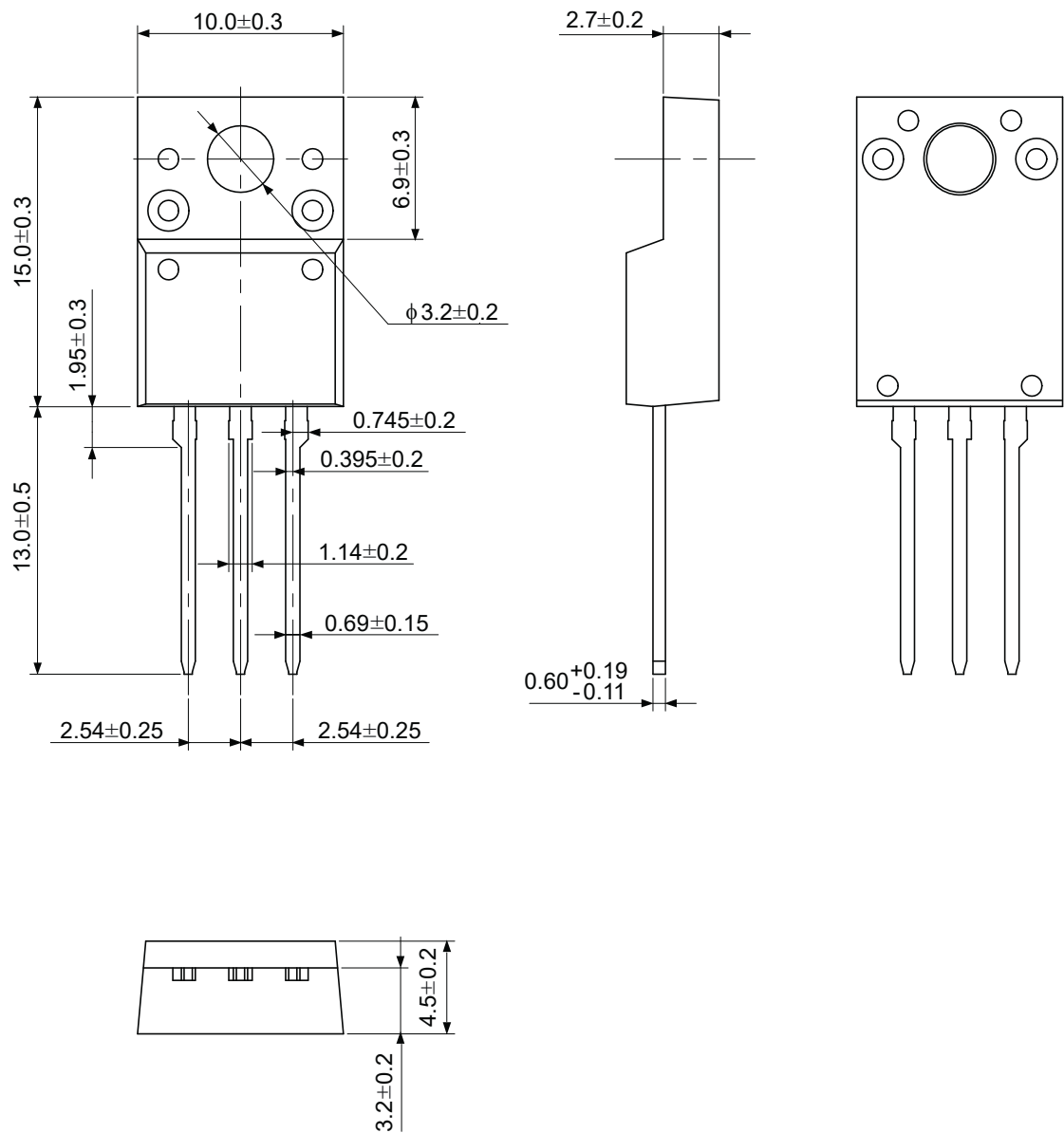

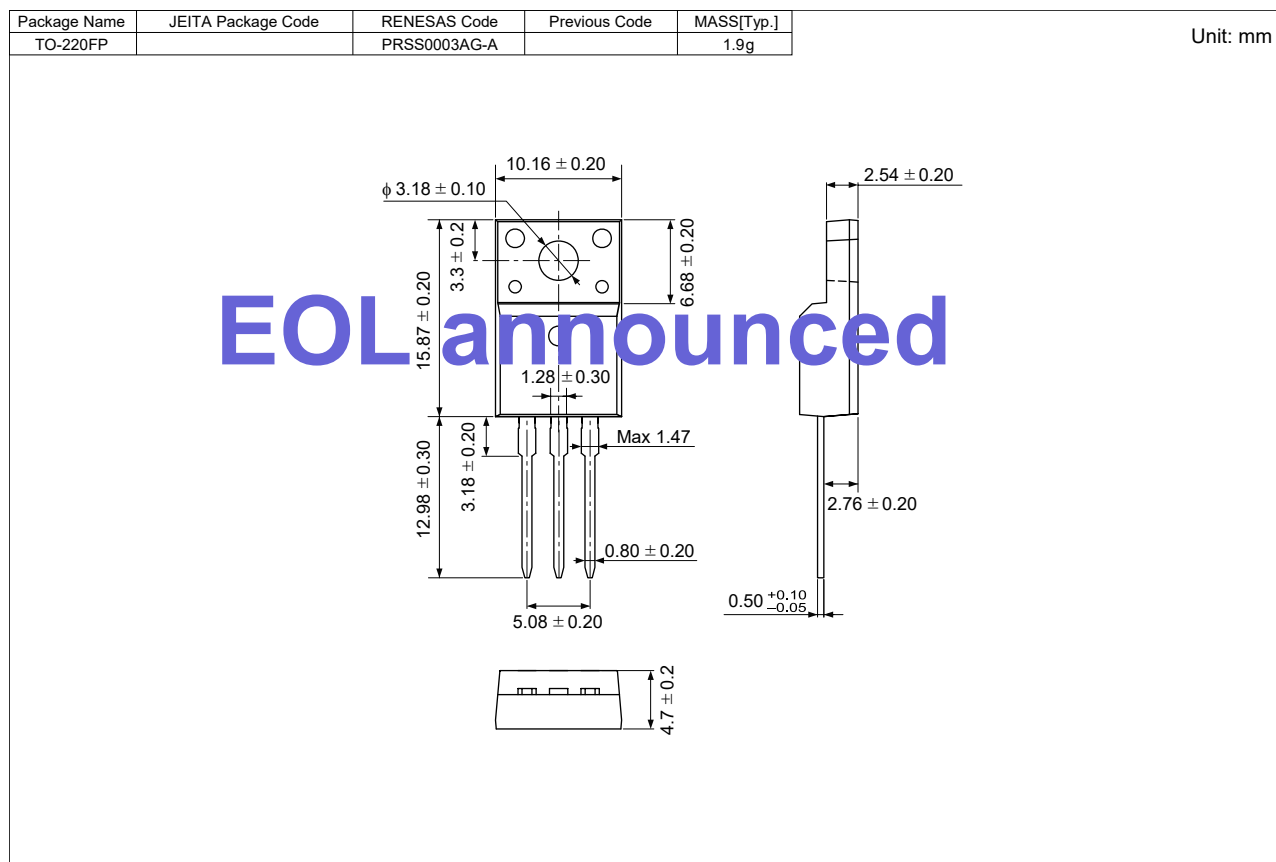
